Reciprocal agreement between Oxford Model Flying Club and Meteors Model Flying Club on use of their flying sites

Members of OMFC and Meteors MFC may fly on both clubs' sites as long as evidence of BMFA insurance is presented. OMFC members wishing to use the Meteors' Frogs Nest Farm site at Bletchingdon, on up to three occasions, will require a guest identity card issued by that club.

SAFETY WARNING

Please note that for 35MHz the Meteors club uses a peg-off frequency control system but OMFC uses the peg-on system. This means that Meteors members flying on Port Meadow and using 35MHz will need to have their own peg showing their channel and name.

For flying on Port Meadow and at Frogs Nest Farm the use of 2.4GHz is recommended.
